- Follow Unser north to Tierra Pintada (second stoplight).
- Turn left onto Tierra Pintada.
- Take Tierra Pintada west to the end to West Creek.
- Turn right (north) onto West Creek.
- Turn right (east) onto Desert Rain.
- Site entrance is a dirt path on the left (north) side, right next to the community park.
